

**RESOLUTION NO. R-2023-00**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA MARQUE, TEXAS  
AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE TO ANDROID CONSTRUCTION

**WHEREAS**, on December 22, 2022 a large waterline failure occurred on the southwest corner of I-45 and Lake Road.

**WHEREAS**, the City was unable to shut down waterline flow due to not having a valve present on the waterline and the contractor was unable to make repairs with the leak.

**WHEREAS**, the contractor installed an emergency Insert-A-Valve, and two Line-Stop Valves in the area in order to control the waterflow.

**WHEREAS**, the invoice, totaling \$40,717.27, exceeds the City Manager's authorization threshold of \$25,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LA MARQUE, TEXAS  
THAT:

The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.

The City Manager is authorized to execute payments in order to settle the invoice.

In the event any clause, phrase, provision sentence, or part of this Resolution or the application of the same to any person or circumstance for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is the intention of the City Council that the invalidity or unconstitutionality of the one or more parts shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Resolution as a whole or any part or provision other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of La Marque, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.
