



Preliminary Training for City of La Marque Fire Department

This training program is provided to aid in the education of battery storage facilities, as well as a guide to ensure adequate safety measures are taken by first responders in case of an emergency. HEN Infrastructure's Emergency Response Fire Training Program was developed to provide remote and on-site training to ensure the City of La Marque Fire Department and Command Staff can perform their duties safely and knowledgeably. Below is a preliminary high-level breakout of the main topics covered during the remote and on-site training, as well as a tentative schedule for when these training courses are to be administered. This training program will be developed with the aide of the Fire Department throughout the permitting process to make certain that it meets the standards and expectations of the City.

Remote/Online Training:

- Remote training course to be conducted by HEN Infrastructure for City of La Marque Fire Department and staff.
- Walkthrough site layout and operation of the battery facility.
- Review technical documentation on site specific safety equipment.
- General understandings and education on the hazards of LFP Batteries.
- Review of site specific UL9540A Test Results.
- **Additional remote training sessions can/will be provided per City's request if necessary.**

On-Site Training:

- 1 day training course for each of the 3 shifts of the La Marque Fire Department.
- Provide overview of site specific safety components.
- Provide a site walkthrough with Fire Department on the location of all emergency related components.

Schedule:

- Remote/ Online Training can be scheduled as early as 30 days after the receipt of all approved permits (est. September 28th, 2023).
- On-Site Training can be scheduled as early as 1 week after mechanical construction is completed (est. December 11th, 2023)
- Annual Training will be scheduled 1 calendar year from the completion of the on-site training of year 1. HEN Infrastructure will coordinate schedule with the Fire Department as the 1 year deadline approaches.

Additions/ Clarifications:

- **All dates listed above are contingent upon HEN Infrastructure obtaining receipt of approval for all permits by the end of August 2023.
