AGENDA ITEM DESCRIPTION: Discussion/ possible action regarding approving new Street Name sign design for intersections within the City

STAFF BRIEFING:

- The existing Street Name signs located at intersections are in need of replacement in most of the older sections of the City.
- The recommended new sign design is Sign # 1; the sign design was reviewed by Keep La Marque Beautiful Commission and they recommend Sign # 1.
- The existing Street Name signs are 4” in height, which is smaller than the regulatory height of 9”, with 6” lettering for upper-case letters and 4” for small-case letters.
- Residential Street Name signs could use 6” height sign with 4” upper-case lettering and 3” small-case letters, but only if speed limits are 25mph or less; the maximum speed limit in residential areas of the City is 30mph.
- The Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) for the State of Texas recommends that Street Name signs have green color for background, but a City may select blue based on jurisdictional preference.
- New Street Name signs will be replaced over the next 2-3 years, beginning on Collector streets and then residential streets within each District.
