

RESOLUTION NO. R-2022-0062

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA MARQUE, TEXAS PROPOSING A TAX RATE FOR THE 2022-2023 FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS, the City of La Marque Texas is required to submit a new operating budget annually;

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2022 in accordance with the Charter of the City of La Marque the City Manager presented a proposed budget to council at a rate of .477076;

WHEREAS, on August 18, 2022 the Galveston County Tax Assessor Collector's Office certified a de minimis rate of .461628; and

WHEREAS, for fiscal year 2022-2023 the City of La Marque Texas proposes a tax rate of .461628 to include a Maintenance and Operations rate of .317891 and an interest and sinking rate of .143737.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LA MARQUE, TEXAS THAT:

The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.

The City Council of the City of La Marque, Texas proposes a tax rate of .461628 comprised of a Maintenance and Operations rate of .317891 and an interest and sinking rate of .143737.

In the event any clause, phrase, provision sentence, or part of this Resolution or the application of the same to any person or circumstance for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it is the intention of the City Council that the invalidity or unconstitutionality of the one or more parts shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Resolution as a whole or any part or provision other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of La Marque, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.
