

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 2023-00**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA MARQUE, TEXAS,  
AWARDING A CONTRACT TO JSS CONSTRUCTION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A 12-  
INCH WATERLINE ON TEXAS AVENUE (FM 1765) FROM I-45 TO NEWMAN ROAD;  
PHASE 1 OF STONEWALL WATERLINE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Department of Transportation is replacing sidewalks on FM 1765 and it is in the fiscal interest of the city to complete a waterline improvements project ahead of the sidewalk replacement; and

**WHEREAS**, the project will construct approximately 11,000 feet (2 mi) of new 12 inch waterlines to provide better flow and pressure in the northeastern sector of the city; and

**WHEREAS**, 12 proposals were received by the deadline of. Wednesday, March 29, 2023, in response to ADICO Project No. 22034-01; and

**WHEREAS**, ADICO, LLC is the city's consulting engineering firm; and

**WHEREAS**, upon full review and consideration of the Evaluation Summary herein attached as Exhibit 'A' and all matters attendant and related thereto, the City Council is of the opinion that ADICO Project No. 22034-01 should be awarded to JSS Construction and that the City Manager should be authorized to execute an Agreement for the services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA MARQUE, TEXAS, THAT:**

Section 1. The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Resolution are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein and made a part hereof for all purposes.

Section 2. The Evaluation Summary for ADICO Project No. 22034-01, having been reviewed by the City Council of the City of La Marque and found to be acceptable and in the best interests of the City of La Marque and its citizens, are hereby in all things awarded.

Section 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement and empowered, for and on behalf of the City, to take all such actions and to execute, verify, acknowledge, certify, file and deliver all such instruments and documents required in the Agreement as shall in the judgment of the City Manager be appropriate in order to affect the purposes of the foregoing resolution and Agreement.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
