

**RESOLUTION NO. 2023-00**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA MARQUE, TEXAS,  
AWARDING BID FOR WESTLAWN FLOOD CONTROL AND DRAINAGE PROJETS;  
AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL  
DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE AN AGREEMENT FOR SUCH  
SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR THE INCORPORATION OF PREAMBLE; AND  
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, in 2020 The Texas General Land Office approved funding for the Westlawn Flood Control and Drainage Project; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 13, 2023, 7 bids were received, reviewed, and analyzed by consulting engineering firm ADICO, LLC; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of La Marque acknowledges that AR Turnkey submitted the lowest Base Bid and that the submitted bid is \$505,653 above the available funds through the City's General Land Office Contract #20-065-105-C287; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of La Marque identifies that additional funding requirements qualify for use of 2020 Certificates of Obligation Bonds to complete the project as designed and approved by the General Land Office Performance Statement; and

**WHEREAS**, upon full review and consideration of the Evaluation Summary, herein attached as Exhibit 'A' and all matters attendant and related thereto, the City Council is of the opinion that this project should be awarded to AR Turnkey Construction and that the City Manager should be authorized to execute an Agreement for the services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LA MARQUE, TEXAS, THAT:**

Section 1. The facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Resolution are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated herein and made a part hereof for all purposes.

Section 2. The Evaluation Summary, having been reviewed by the City Council of the City of La Marque and found to be acceptable and in the best interests of the City of La Marque and its citizens, is hereby in all things awarded.

Section 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement and empowered, for and on behalf of the City, to take all such actions and to execute, verify, acknowledge, certify, file and deliver all such instruments and documents required in the Agreement as shall in the judgment of the City Manager be appropriate in order to affect the purposes of the foregoing resolution and Agreement.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
