PERFORMANCE STATEMENT

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development’s Community Development Block Grant Mitigation (“CDBG-MIT”) program to provide financial assistance with funds appropriated under Public Law 115-123, was enacted on August 30, 2019, to facilitate disaster recovery, restoration, mitigation, and economic revitalization and to affirmatively further fair housing, in accordance with Executive Order 12892, in areas affected by 2015, 2016, and 2017 disasters, which are Presidentially-declared major disaster areas under Title IV of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. § 5121, *et seq.*).

In strict conformance with the terms and conditions of the Hurricane Harvey HUD Most Impacted and Distressed (HMID) Competition and this Contract, City of La Marque (Subrecipient) shall perform, or cause to be performed, the Infrastructure Activities defined below.

The Subrecipient has identified sewer facility activities that will increase resilience to disasters and reduce or eliminate the long-term risk of loss of life, injury, damage to and loss of property, and suffering and hardship, by lessening the impact of future disasters.

Subrecipient shall perform the activities identified herein for the target area specified in its approved Texas Community Development Block Grant Mitigation Grant Application to provide a long-lasting investment that increases resiliency in the community. The persons to benefit from the activities described herein must receive the prescribed service or benefit, and all eligibility requirements must be met to fulfill contractual obligations.

The grant total is \$48,904,004.00. Subrecipient will be required to maintain a detailed budget breakdown in the official system of record of the GLO’s Community Development and Revitalization (GLO-CDR) division.

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Sewer Facilities

Subrecipient shall elevate, enclose, and floodproof the existing wastewater treatment plant walls; install and construct additional equipment for the WWTP to increase capacity by 2.25 million gallons per day of sewage flow. Subrecipient shall also convert 21 lift stations to self-priming pumps, increase the capacity of the lift stations, elevate and install emergency backup pumps, and complete all associated appurtenances. Construction shall take place at the following locations, including mid-point coordinates for each segment.
